FACT SHEET

CAUSTIC WHEAT

Caustic Wheat is wheat treated caustic soda (sodium hydroxide). The sodium hydroxide coating acts as an alkali to the acids produced in the rumen, therefore helping to promote stable rumen conditions, which is essential; for efficient feed utilization and reducing the risk of problems associated with feeding high levels of rolled cereals or acidic silages.

The reduction in acid loading in the rumen in turn leads to increased milk yield and quality in dairy cows and increased live weight gain and feed conversion in beef cattle.

Inclusion Rate. *Dairy & Beef feed up to 4 kg/head/day*

Storage & Handling Feeding of Caustic Wheat can commence 5 days after treatment. Please allow 5 working days from placing the order to delivery. Once tipped onto a clean surface on farm inside or outside (if covered), Caustic Wheat should usually be used within three weeks. Animals should have constant access to clean water. Caustic Wheat should be introduced to any diet gradually over a period of time (7-14 days).
