FACT SHEET

PROCESSED BREAD

Processed Bread is a highly digestible feed which is high in energy, mainly derived from starch (or actually has higher starch levels than cereals)

Bread which is deemed unsuitable for human consumption (this can be for various reasons: uneven cooking, damage, sell by date exceeded etc.) is collected fresh from the bakery and processed daily. The bread is then cleaned, broken up and stripped of wrapping (PLEASE NOTE: it cannot be guaranteed 100% free from wrapping)

With dairy cows, it can be included in diets at up to 6kg per day but it should ideally be introduced gradually over 14 days. Feed rates for Beef cattle must not exceed 50% of the total Dry Matter intake of the animal and as before, should be build up gradually.

IT IS VERY IMPORTANT that bread is fed with long fibre i.e. silage, hay or straw to prevent acidosis.
